



## Alert - New VBM Request Form and Updated Voter Registration Form

Recent legislation (SB 7050 signed in May 2023) required the Division of Elections (DOE) to prescribe a rule for a uniform statewide request for a vote-by-mail ballot and to update the voter registration application to reference requirements for third party registration organizations (3PVRs).

### New - Statewide Vote-By-Mail Ballot Request Form DS-DE 160 – Effective April 17, 2024

- Requires Date of Birth AND FL ID/Driver License #; if no ID or DL, then last 4 of SSN
- Provides for the delivery to a mailing address other than the voter’s home address (optional)
- Includes space for phone and email (both optional)
- Requires a signature
- Includes a section to be completed when the VBM ballot is being requested by someone else (optional)

### Updated - Voter Registration Form DS-DE 39 – Effective April 24, 2024

- Adds QR Code to the On-Line Voter Registration System
- Adds a statement defining requirements for 3PVRs
- Clarifies voter registration requirements
- Reformats the section to be completed by the voter or prospective voter from 12 lines to 15 (1-6 & 15 are now required)
